David Snyder became executive director of the New Hampshire Bar Foundation in 2003 and is responsible for the oversight of the Bar Foundation and its IOLTA Program. The Bar Foundation distributes approximately \$1.8 million dollars a year in grants to legal service organizations and law-related education programs in New Hampshire.

A resident of Concord, David has worked in various capacities for New Hampshire non-profit organizations over the past 16 years. Until 2003, he served as director of philanthropy for the Concord Area Chapter of the American Red Cross. He also served as director of operations for the League of NH Craftsmen, and as grants and information officer for the NH State Council on the Arts.

Snyder served in the United States Army and earned his bachelor's degree in liberal studies from Boston University in 1986. He is a board member of CONFR (Continuing Education in Fund Raising), the New Hampshire Writer's Project, and recently served on the Concord School Board.
