Racheal Stuart is Vice President of Program at NH Charitable Foundation, where she serves on the Senior Management Team, and represents the Foundation in a range of activities in the public, private and nonprofit sectors, statewide and nationally. She provides oversight for the Foundation's grantmaking, scholarships and initiatives, totaling about \$19 Million in 2004. Her responsibilities include working with staff to design and implement programs and public-private partnerships to address community issues as varied as social capital, substance abuse, affordable housing, and nonprofit effectiveness and accountability. In addition, Racheal works directly with staff and Foundation advisors around the state to identify and direct support to emerging needs and opportunities. Prior to joining the Charitable Foundation in 1998, Racheal was the founding Executive Director of the Women's Business Center in Portsmouth, a nonprofit business development center providing training, capital access programs and support for women's business ownership.
